She showed beautiful quilts from her collection of One Block Wonder quilts and was able to show examples of the original fabric that was transformed to achieve the final quilt. Sue discussed fabric choices, fabric design repeats and showed many examples of fabrics that would work very well to create the kaleidoscope effect for the One Block Wonder quilt.

Community Service - BOM

We are going try this pattern once more. Response from last month was rather feeble.

We will be constructing blocks to use in a future project. You can turn these blocks in at the February or March meeting.

Using 4 1/2" squares, construct a churn dash block. Finished size should be 12.5",

White or off-white background with pink or purple (think spring flowers).
