*Volunteers requested to sew blocks from "Design a Quilt Block" program that will ultimately become quilts for Oshei Childrens Hospital. By the end of the meeting all blocks were taken.

*We are having some issues with the website which are being worked on; your patience is appreciated.

*Our February 2026 meeting will be held on February 26, the 4th Thursday of the month due to a conflict with a library event on the 3rd Thursday. Members will be reminded in the newsletter, etc.

*Kathleen will be selling fabric at \$5/lb. with all proceeds going to the SPCA and animal rescue organizations per this retired quilter. Fabric sale will begin on Monday afternoon. Please contact Kathleen if interested in purchasing fabric.

*YTD income is greater than budget, due mainly to fabric sales, AccuCut sale and donations of fabric for sale. AQG also has program income from 50/50 and guest fees that we hadn't expected.

Expenses for rental space is only half of what was budgeted as we no longer meet at the church and our meeting space is at no charge. However, we have had new unplanned expenses for brochures, our website, name tags, bank fees, etc. But overall, we are in great shape with YTD income greater than YTD expenses!

October Program – Rebecca Ribis introduced our speaker, Susan Ralyea from BC Woolery in Almond, NY who spoke on Working with Wool for Applique. Susan spoke about different types of wool, how to work with wool, different types of thread, combining wool appliqué with traditional quilt fabric and design, blanket stitch and decorative embroidery stitches and embellishments. She showed many examples of wool appliqué projects and quilts.

AQG 2025 Challenge Quilt - Make It Modern

The 2025 Challenge Quilt theme is Modern Quilts. Members are encouraged to create a small quilt that incorporates one or more of the principles of modern quilting:

Rules - Challenge quilts will be original design

- 1. no larger than 120" perimeter
- 2. comprised of three layers (top, batting, and backing)
- 3. bound and quilted through all three layers and have visible quilting by hand, by machine, or both
- 4. made using fabrics of any color
- 5. made using any of the following techniques: pieced, foundation pieced, English paper pieced, hand or machine appliqued, hand or machine embroidered.
